

years and 10 months of age to register The new online pre-registration applies to California youth who are 16 or 17 and meet the following criteria:

A United States citizen and a resident of California,

Texas permits a person who is 17

- Not currently serving a state or federal prison term for the conviction of a felony (for more information on the rights of people who have been incarcerated, please see the Secretary of State's Voting Rights: Persons with a Criminal History), and
- Not currently found mentally incompetent to vote by a court (for more information, please see <u>Voting Rights</u>: Persons Subject to Conservatorship).

Some states allow individuals as young as 16 to pre-register to vote by completing the online voter registration, providing first-time youth voters sufficient time and opportunity to get ready to vote. Pre-registration does not change the voting age, which remains at 18 years old across the country. Pre registration is available to youth who are:
